The hotel has a Full Service Restaurant and a Bar overlooking Corpus Christi Bay, a 24-hour Business Center, an Exercise Room, an Outdoor Pool and Cabana Bar, and Miles of sandy beach.

Things to do in Corpus Christi;

There will be no planned excursions. The following are things to do “on your own” while in Corpus Christi.

The Radisson Hotel is located on Corpus Christi Beach on the north side of the Harbor Bridge. The USS Lexington Aircraft Carrier and Museum, www.ussexington.com and the Texas State Aquarium, www.texasstateaquarium.org, are also on the beach. A short drive will take you to the American Bank Center (event Center), Selena Auditorium, Solomon Ortiz Center, The Port of Corpus Christi, Corpus Christi History and Science Museum, Heritage Park, Corpus Christi Marina and Whataburger Field-the home of the Corpus Christi Hooks Baseball Team. The Peddler Show will be in Corpus Christi Nov 5-7 at the Richard Borchard Fairgrounds just a 20 minute drive from the hotel www.peddlershow.com.

Kingsville is only an hour drive from the hotel. Kingsville is home to the historic King Ranch, www.king-ranch.com. Tours of the ranch headquarters are offered every day. In Kingsville are the King Ranch Museum and the King Ranch Saddle Shop (for purchases of handmade leather goods and Western items) www.krsaddleshop.com.

Port Aransas, Mustang Island, North Padre Island, and the Padre Island National Seashore are all within an hour drive as well.

Blackbeards Restaurant is across the parking lot from the hotel. Blackbeards serves seafood as well as beef, chicken and Mexican food. There are other seafood restaurants within walking distance. There are also souvenir shops all along the beach area. The City operates a Trolley Service along the beach area.
